HISTORIC DOWNTOWN WALKING TOUR

We will explore the impressive Mexico City, built on top of the ruins of the Aztec capital of Tenochtitlan. Our first stop is the Zocalo main square, one of the biggest in the world. We will visit the Metropolitan Cathedral the biggest church in Latin America and the National Palace, which hosts Diego Rivera's murals depicting the history of Mexico. Our last stop is the Museum of Anthropology, where we will have some time to explore the hall of Mexican history.
